

Public information on SUSCON activities and results at the “Researcher’s Evening” - 22nd September 2006

On Friday, the 22nd of September 2006, the Laboratory of Environmental Engineering GAIA of the University of Cyprus participated in the “Researcher’s Evening”, an event organised by the Cyprus Research Promotion Foundation in co-ordination with other authorities. The event was



under the auspices of the president of Cyprus, and was part of a European initiative focusing on research. The primary aim of the event was to support and strengthen the image of the researchers in the society, and to emphasise their importance, while encouraging youth to follow a career in research.



During the event, researchers and postgraduate students of the Laboratory were informing the public and distributing information leaflets for the research taking place at GAIA including the SUSCON initiative, implemented by the Laboratory in cooperation with the National

Technical University of Athens, the Technical Chamber of Cyprus; the construction companies Edrasis in Greece and Cybarco in Cyprus and the technical consulting company EPTA. The project aims at the adoption of the sustainable construction concept in public and private works through the IPP approach and is co-funded by the LIFE-Environment programme of the European Community. The project started in October 2005 and is expected to finish in September 2008.
