Horizon 2020 After nearly 4 years of implementation

Interim Evaluation

- ✓ An attractive, simplified and well-performing € 77 billion programme, but underfunded (12% success rate)
- On track to deliver value for money and to meet its knowledge-creating objectives
- Strong EU Added Value through unique opportunities, competition & access to new knowledge.

Participation (Oct. 2017)

- ✓ 15,000 grant agreements
- ✓ with \in 27 billion EU contribution
- ✓ 65,000 participations

Societal Challenge 5: Climate action, environment, resource efficiency and raw materials - Work Programme 2018-2020

- Focus:
 - moving to a greener, more resource efficient and climate-resilient economy in sync with the natural environment
 - demonstrating a strong commitment to supporting the UN's Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and the targets of the COP21 Paris Agreement

2 multiannual calls:

"Building a low-carbon, climate resilient future: climate action in support of the Paris Agreement"

"Greening the economy in line with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)"

- Total indicative budget 2018-2020 €1.1bn
- 2019 topics open: 14 November 2018

- Inter-relations between climate change, biodiversity and ecosystem services
- ✓ The Cryosphere

LIFE 2018-2020 MAWP

♦ Remaining allocation for MAWP2: €1.66 billion

- ♦ €1,24 billion for ENV Sub-programme (mean: €413 million/year)
- ♦ €0,41 billion for CLIMA Sub-programme (mean: €137 million/year)

LIFE MAWP 2018-2020 (I)

As in MAWP1, strong emphasis on:

- Long term sustainability of the project: continuation, replication and transfer
- EU added value
- Indicators

New priority topics and evaluation criteria

Consider findings of the Mid-Term evaluation:

- Simplification of the application & reporting processes
- Replication of project results
- Improving the communication strategy





LIFE MAWP 2018-2020 (II)

Takes up recent development in EU policy, e.g.:

- Circular Economy Action Plan
- Action Plan for nature, people and the economy

For ENV Sub-programme:

- Reduced number of topics (87 to 42) and stronger focus to EU policy priorities
- Reorientation of GI project topics to focus on more specific awareness raising and governance-related issues





LIFE MAWP 2018-2020 (III)

For both Sub-Programmes:

- Further enhancement of the results-orientation by introducing the requirement to produce measurable effects under all priority areas
- Encouragement to further engage private entities by highlighting the advantages of the Close-to-Market approaches
- Simplification of the grant management procedure
