Goals of LIFE UNIFY on the local level

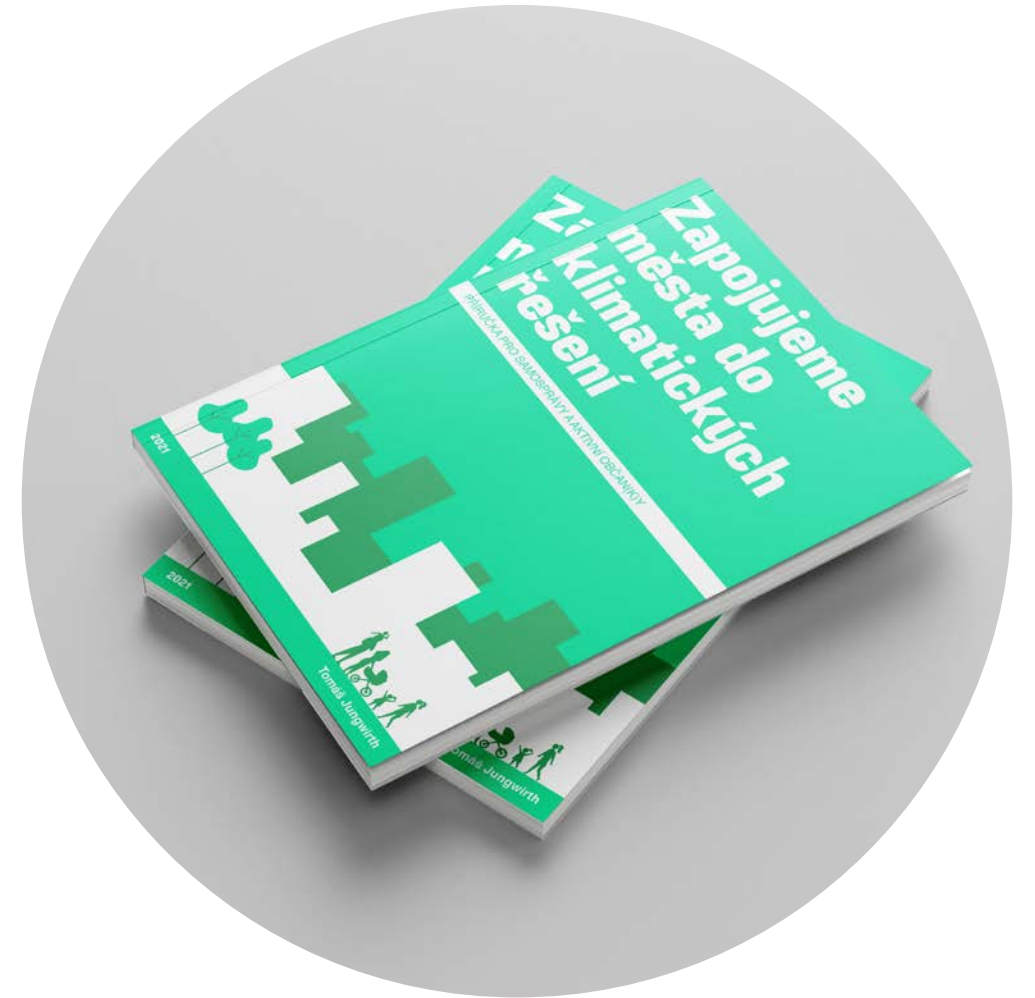
- Advocacy in favour of the Covenant of Mayors agenda in six target countries

What do we envisage municipalities doing?

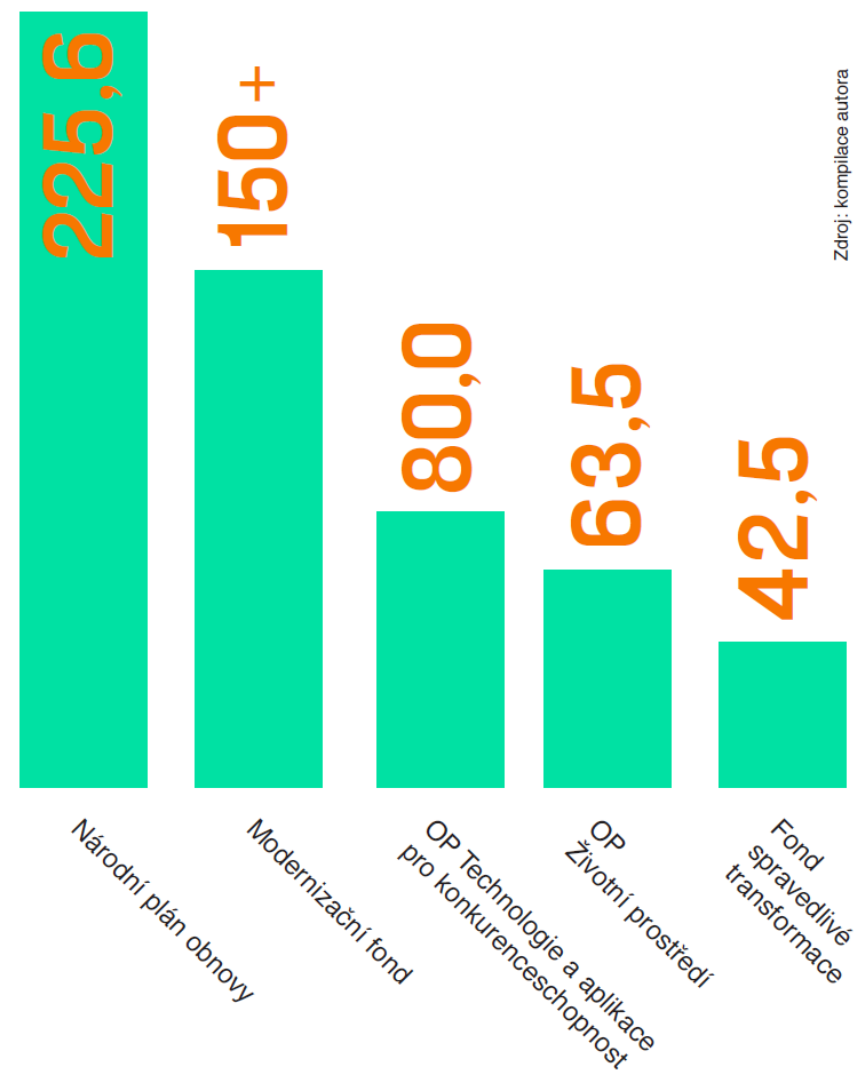
- Joining the Covenant of Mayors

Key arguments we use in Czechia
